The BC Government and Service Employees' Union (BCGEU) is pleased to once again offer scholarships for post-secondary studies undertaken by BCGEU members, staff and their families.

We are proud that our scholarship program, funded by our 80,000 members' dues, will offer \$60,000 in 2021 to full and part-time students. Successful students are eligible for scholarships of \$2,000 for full-time and \$1,000 for part-time studies.
